Sultan of Maldives is a beautiful locally crafted 30 meter teakwood boat, offering a high standard of comfort and service.

Accommodation

Sultan of Maldives offers eight cabins, six double and two twin cabins fully air-conditioned, with individual thermostat control, en suite shower and WC.

Each individual cabin is comfortably furnished and includes porthole, fan, safe, wardrobe and storage space under the beds. Complimentary toilet packs, blankets, towels and slippers are supplied in each cabin.

All Aboard

There are three beautifully crafted teak wooden decks, one sheltered intimate bar/cafeteria surrounded by dinette sofas; one open air deck in front of the bar and a sundeck solarium located on the upper bridge.

Buffet meals are provided in the air-conditioned dining room on the deck and barbecues and picnic lunches on uninhabited islands where our guests have the opportunity to experience Maldives , in authentic “Robinson Crusoe” style.

The lounge/dining and entertainment area are equipped with flat-screen TV, Bose Lifestyle® Home Entertainment system for playback music, books, board games and a multi-media library with DVD movies.

Diving

There is a PADI Dive Instructor on board, leading three dives per day (inclusive of three night dives per week). All dives are taken from the auxiliary dive Dhoni (boat) which

accompanies Sultan of Maldives. This ensures maximum manoeuvrability within the reefs, leaving Sultan of Maldives free to continue its cruise itinerary.

For each diver, a complimentary DAN (Divers Alert Network) Europe insurance is provided which will cover transportation and decompression-chamber treatment.

Other Activities

Canoeing and snorkelling equipment is available FREE of charge for those who do not wish to indulge in diving, but still wish to experience the beauty of the Maldivian waters.

For those who are more adventurous Jet-ski and water skiing is also available for a nominal fee.
